Please read through and review the following adoption policies and general information.

FREE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: All animals at MACC are given a general physical examination upon intake. We strongly encourage you to take your new pet to one of the participating veterinary clinics within the next two weeks for a free follow-up exam. This exam does not include tests, x-rays or other medical work. A list of these vet clinics is included in the adoption folder.

QUARANTINE PERIOD: We strongly advise you to keep your newly adopted pet isolated from your existing pets until your veterinarian confirms its health. MACC is unable to treat pets currently in your home, which may be exposed to illness from your newly adopted pet. In addition, this separation time will allow you to appropriately plan pet-to-pet introductions.

PET LICENSE: All dogs, cats, and ferrets in Minneapolis are required to be licensed. Minneapolis residents must purchase a pet license at the time of adoption. You are responsible for keeping the pet license current.

RABIES VACCINATIONS: All dogs, cats, and ferrets are required to have a Rabies vaccination. Your new pet has received a 1 (one) year Rabies Vaccination. You are responsible for keeping the vaccination current.

RETURN POLICY: MACC states that the adopter may return this animal within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date of adoption and receive a full refund. Processing time for refunds is 6-8 weeks. Once an animal has been returned, the adopter must wait 7 days before adopting again.

OWNERSHIP AGREEMENT: As the new owner, you agree to take full responsibility for the care and well-being of this pet for its lifetime. Once the adoption is finalized, you will be responsible for all medical bills and decisions regarding this animal.
