

A future mixed-use democracy center and community space









Democracy center and community space

The former 3rd Police Precinct building stands at 3000 Minnehaha Avenue. It has been vacant since the murder of George Floyd and the civil unrest that followed in 2020.

The City of Minneapolis is proposing to redevelop the building into a democracy center and community space. It would house Elections and Voter Services and a large, groundfloor space for community use.

For years our Election and Voter Services has been housed in a rented space in Northeast Minneapolis.


