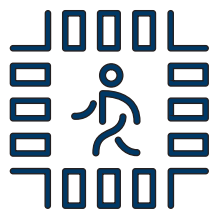


Safe Routes to School Demonstration Project Coming Soon!

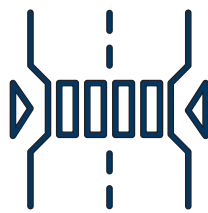
Demonstration projects are temporary roadway projects that use low-cost materials to evaluate changes to the street before potentially investing in longer-term solutions.
