2025 collection of leaves and bundled brush ends the week of Nov. 24

Yard waste collection goes through November. Your collection day the week of Nov. 24-29 will be your last pickup of leaves, brush and other yard trimmings. There will be no additional yard waste service after your last scheduled pickup day.

How to set out yard waste

- Compostable bags (paper lawn and leaf bags or BPI certified compostable plastic bags)
- Reusable container (32-38 gallons in size, with sturdy handles and no wheels)

Set all yard waste next to your carts by 6 a.m. on your pickup day. Yard waste is not allowed in Cityprovided containers.

Size and weight requirements

- Max weight of 40 lbs. for bags, reusable containers or bundled brush.
- Brush must be shorter than 3 feet long and less than 3 inches in diameter.
- Brush must be in a container or bundled with string or twine (no tape).



Cars must be moved so crews can clear debris and leaves from the streets. Signs will be posted at least 24 hours before towing begins. Signs will specify the day of the week that parking is banned and read "No Parking 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m."



Don't get towed



Watch for "no parking" signs each day or if you can't, arrange with a friend for help.
