## Who is Public Works?

The Department of Public Works designs, builds and maintains the City of Minneapolis' infrastructure, which includes but is not limited to: streets and bridges, public buildings, City's fleet of vehicles, storm and sanitary sewer system, drinking water treatment and distribution, all public and off-street parking, traffic signals, signage and striping; solid waste and recycling, and more.

# The internship

The Traffic and Parking Services aims to maintain the movement of people, services and goods throughout the city across all modes of travel. The On-Street and Mobility teams are responsible for 9,500 paid on street parking spaces with 750 pay stations, regulates over 1,000 miles of curb, and oversees the multi-modal mobility program. The division as a whole also operates 13 parking ramps alongside the Impound Lot, maintains 20,000 streetlights, and holds responsibility for traffic management through mechanisms such as signs, signals and lane striping.


