HOW TO USE A CONDOM

1 CHECK THE EXPIRATION DATE

 Usually found on the back of the package in small writing:



EXAMINE PACKAGE & OPEN CAREFULLY

- Check to make sure the package is in good shape, there is no clear damage or wear and tear.
- Teeth, fingernails, scissors, or anything sharp can damage the package- open it carefully!



FIGURE OUT WHICH WAY CONDOM UNROLLS

 You can test this by putting the condom over a finger (or knuckle if you have longer fingernails).
 The correct way will roll down easily. It looks like a little rimmed hat.





PINCH THE TIP, ROLL IT DOWN

 Pinch the tip of the condom with two fingers and a thumb- This prevents air from taking up space and leaves room for potential semen.





VAGINAL, ANAL, OR ORAL SEX WITH CONDOM

 Keep the condom on the entire time during sex, continue to ensure there is consent!



6 HOLD THE BASE, PULL OUT

- Some people may ejaculate, or cum, during sex. If someone ejaculates, take the penis out while it is still hard.
- Hold the rim of the condom around the base of the penis as it is being pulled out.

7 TAKE OFF & THROW AWAY

- Make sure the penis is away from your partner's body before removing the condom.
- Throw the used condom away.
 Never use a condom more than once.

CONDOM TIPS

- Keep condoms handy- store them near where you usually have sex
- Try lubrication to increase condom effectiveness and pleasure
 - Water-based lube can be added to the inside and outside of a condom
- Don't use oil-based lube like vaseline, coconut oil, or lotions
- Try several kinds to find what you like best.
 - Condoms come in a variety of sizes, textures, flavors, and types!
- Practice putting on a condom by yourself, before you're with a partner.
