What we know

- Traffic safety impacts everyone
- A small amount of our streets (9%) are where the majority of severe and fatal crashes happen (66%)
- People walking and biking, and historically marginalized groups are overrepresented in severe and fatal crashes
- Quick-build safety improvements are proven quick and effective ways to address traffic safety

Safety improvements

- Lyndale Ave N is identified as a High Injury Street from 24th Ave to 49th Ave
 - High Injury Streets are streets where the highest number of severe and fatal crashes occur in Minneapolis
- Quick-build safety improvements will be installed in 2023
- The type of improvements you will see along Lyndale Ave N this year will include:
 - bumpouts
 - pedestrian medians
 - hardened centerlines

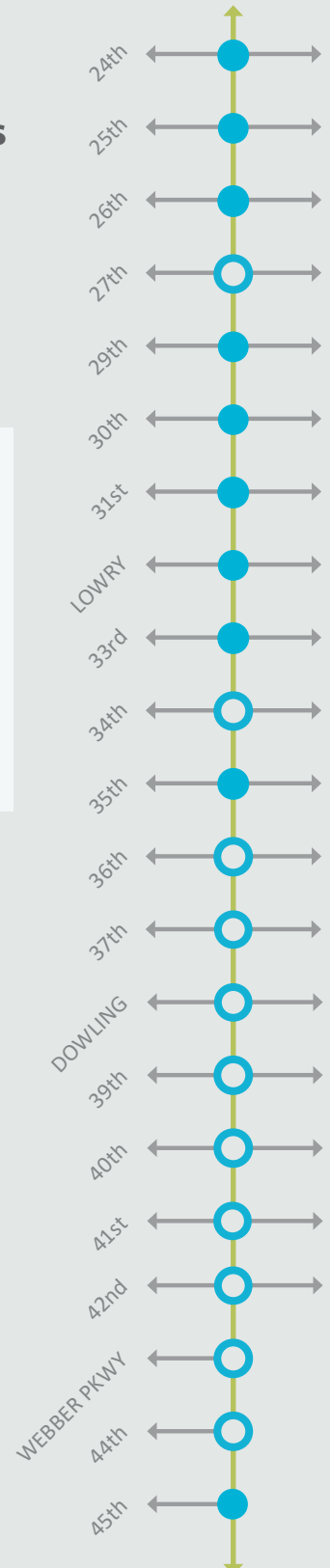

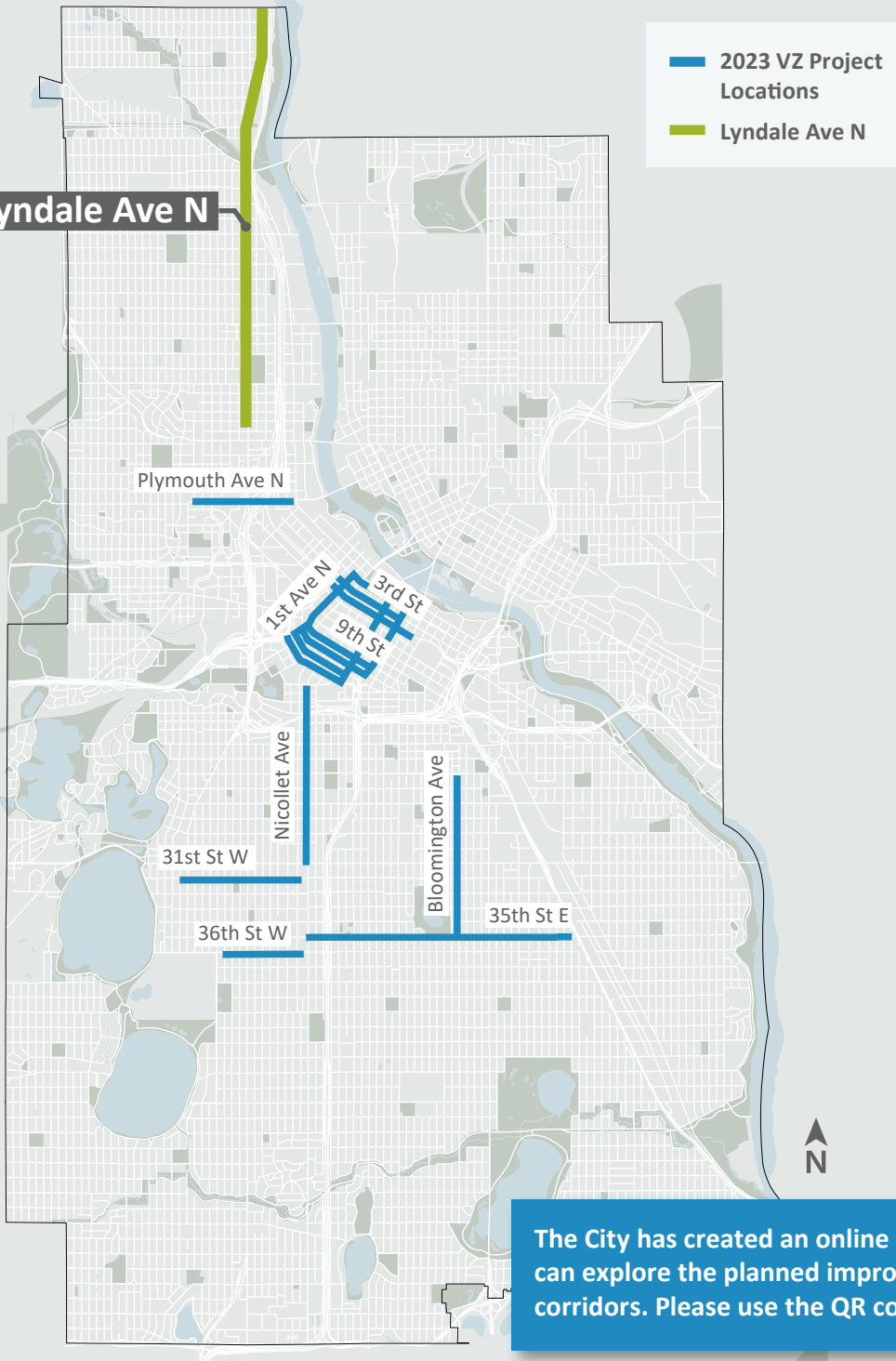
