

West Fulton Neighborhood Improvement Project

Project background

The Minneapolis Department of Public Works is planning to make improvements to neighborhood streets in the western section of the Fulton neighborhood. The project area extends from France to Xerxes avenues and from 47th St to 54th St. The project will repair or replace deteriorating pavement, install rain gardens to help filter stormwater, and implement bike network upgrades. It will also include stormwater treatment practices to meet the City’s stormwater ordinance, along with making pedestrian and bicycle improvements consistent with adopted city policies. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pedestrian ramp upgrade work was completed in 2025 south of 50th St. Pavement resurfacing work and rain garden construction will begin in 2026.

Project schedule

The final design phase is underway. Improvements began in 2025 and will be phased over the next several years.
