Narrative

E6 was dispatched to a shooting at 15 East Grant St. E6 staged at Nicollet and W. 15th St waited for code 4. Report of another victim came in. E6 requested E10 for additional resources. Reports of an active shooter and multiple victims started coming in. E10 requested an initial assignment and a TAC channel.

BC1 arrived to 12th and Nicollet, assumed command and set up a fire command post on 12th and Nicollet.

E6, E10 and L11 staged then met with MPD and made entry into the building. E6 and E10 was assigned to Task Force 2, L11 assigned to Task Force 1. All crews using stairwell and heading to the 9th floor.

E6 and E10 came across a critical patient with gun shot wounds, placed them on a mega mover and brought them to the elevator. E6 continued with patient care providing BLS in the elevator, loading the patient onto the stretcher in the lobby with medics assisting the medics w BLS riding in the ambulance down to the stab room.

Fire personnel from the training division were at HCMC at the time of the incident and assisted medics with unloading patients from the ambulances to the ER.

E10 returned to the 9th floor with L11 and continued searching the floor with MPD. Crews came across 2 patients who were DOA. E10 assisted medics with a patient who was sheltering in place in apt 902 and having chest pain. E10 assisted medics with loading the patient onto the stretcher then stayed to help L11 and PD search several floors for possible victims.

Duty Deputy and ISO self-dispatched to the scene. Command requested 2 more engines and 1 ladder for extra resources. Duty Deputy was Senior Advisor and assisted with calling dispatch, requesting salvage and communicating with PD. Command requested Mobile Command to the scene. 10-2 also arrived to the scene as a senior advisor.

ISO was made Staging Supervisor- with them was 10-2, E8, E16 and L3. Forward staging was set up at 14th and Nicollet.

Salvage set up rehab at 14th and Nicollet.

All crews were directed to leave the medical corridor open which was Nicollet Ave and 12th street.

PD requested a fire crew for forcible entry with saws and tools. Command had E8 grab the equipment meet with PD in the lobby.

Report of the shooter down. Crews still searched for possible patients.

PD requested the fire alarm to be shut off and a water leak stopped that affecting floors 6-9. E16 to silence the alarm.

Forcible entry was canceled so E8 assisted with shutting down the water supply to the building.

Once all floors were searched by MPD and interior fire crews, all fire crews went to staging. Scene stabilized.

Command released E8, E16 and L3. PD requested initial assignment to stay on scene for investigation. E6, E10, L11 and BC1 to remain on scene. Shortly after, all crews were released from the scene.
